



Waste Management Policy

LIVECO Limited T/A VEST Construction will ensure that the requirements, both legislative and best practice, for the management, handling and disposal of waste, are observed in all areas for which it is responsible, including the Waste Management Act 1996 and all relevant Environmental Legislation.

Under Section 32 of the Waste Management Act 1996, VEST Construction observe and comply with their duty to take all reasonable measures applicable to them to prevent the escape of waste from their control, to safely transfer all wastes to an authorised person or to a person for authorised transport purposes and to provide a written description of the waste for other persons.

The Company recognises the importance of correct waste disposal and the part that all staff must play to achieve this. Staff will be given training, both at induction and regularly thereafter, in the segregation and handling of waste.

The Company and its staff will plan the works, storage, sequencing, etc. to minimise the waste derived from our sites. The Company will also work with its suppliers to try and minimise the amount of packaging etc. used on the materials it buys.

Where site conditions permit waste segregation will be dealt with on site to ensure that our waste can be recycled. Where this is not possible the waste will be disposed of via a Waste Management Centre where it will be sorted and recycled to minimise the amount which ends up in landfill sites.

The Company will also install and maintain an adequate level of waste disposal infrastructure, designed to encourage a safe working environment that safeguards staff and visitors.
